



When printing this pattern it is important to print it full size. When you bring up the print dialog box look in the "Page Sizing & Handling" section. Make sure the "Actual Size" is selected before you hit print.

You also only need to print the page/s you need. After the print dialog opens look for the "Pages to Print" section. You can print the current page or a range of pages. This will help save ink by not printing the title/instruction pages.


Valentine Round Box





To make the heart and ribbon we will stack cut two different boards. The lower board will be the heart and is 1/4" Thick. The top board will be the ribbon and is 1/2" Thick.

Sandwich the two boards together and wrap them with blue painters tape. Apply the pattern with the thicker board on top.






Cut around all the shapes with a #1 blade. We will use parts of each board. Keep the thicker board parts for the ribbon. Keep the thinner board parts for the heart. Everything else is waste.






Contour the edges of the ribbon using a sanding drum or what ever tools you have handy.
Round over the outside edges of the heart pieces.
Glue the pieces together into one piece.








Glue the lid and the rim together. Glue the bottom to the box walls. Clamp and let the glue dry. Install the lid on the box and sand all the pieces flush.






Glue the heart/ribbon to the box top.

Complete with your choice of finish. I used spray lacquer.
