The picture shows my prototype. The patten has 7 links instead of just four.

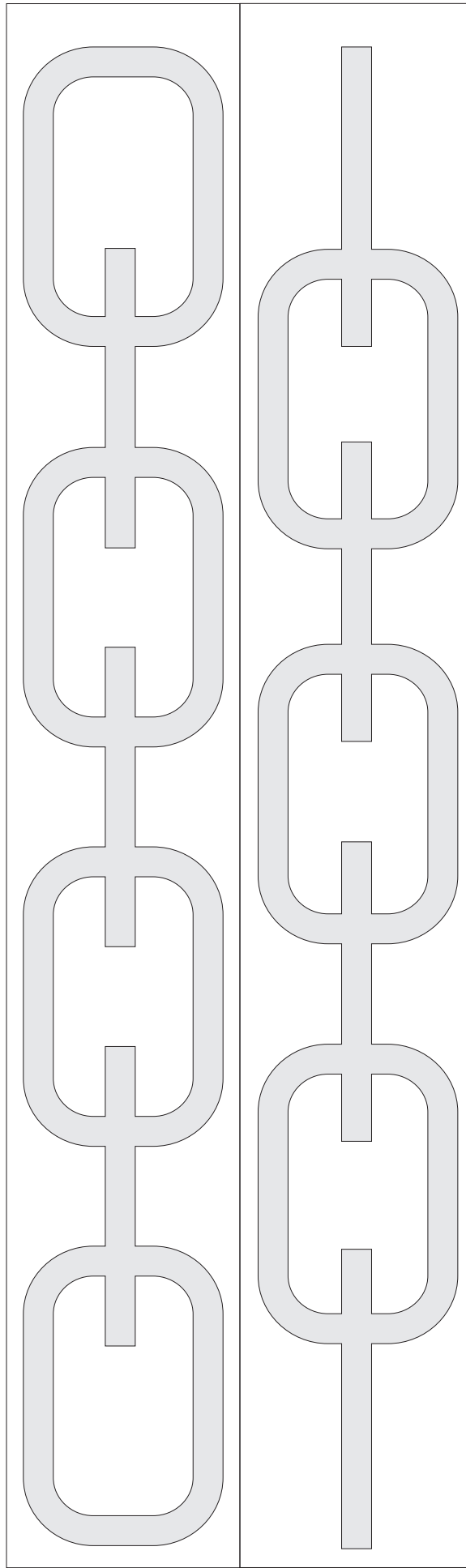
This project is a compound cut piece. Most of the cuts will be completed on the scroll saw. There are a few finish cuts that will require an Exacto blade.

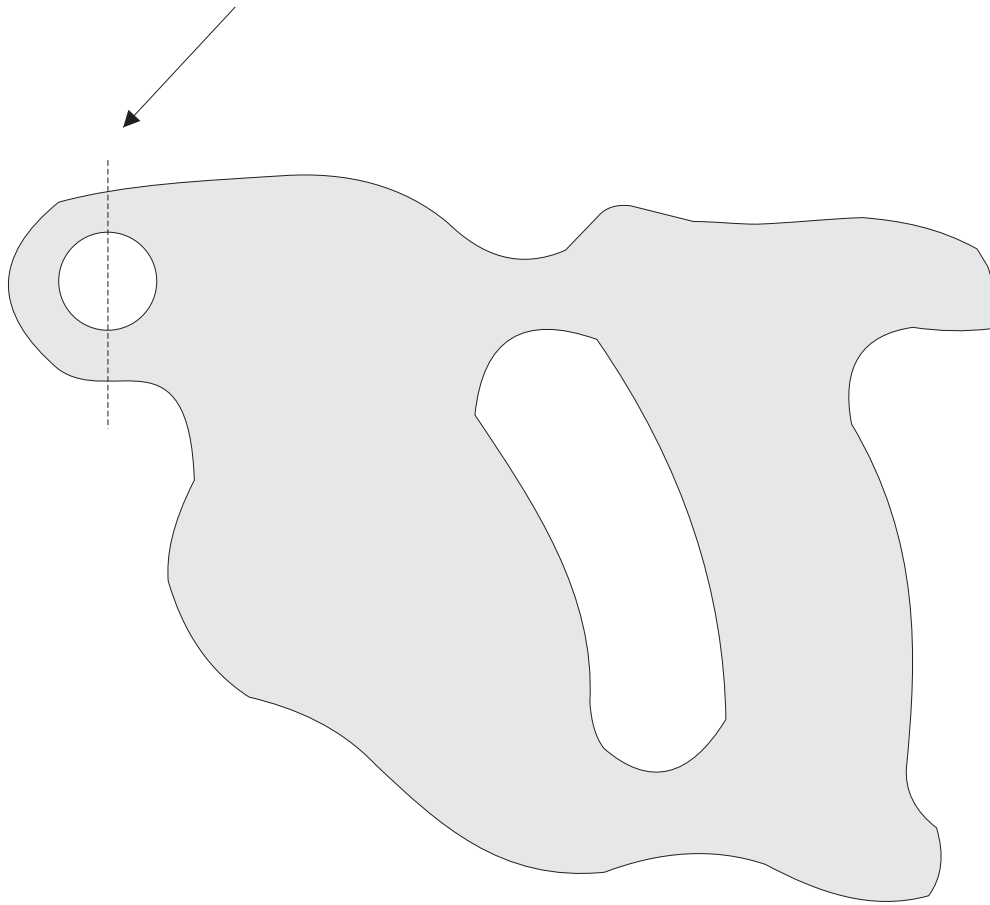
You need a board that is 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"



7 Link Chain

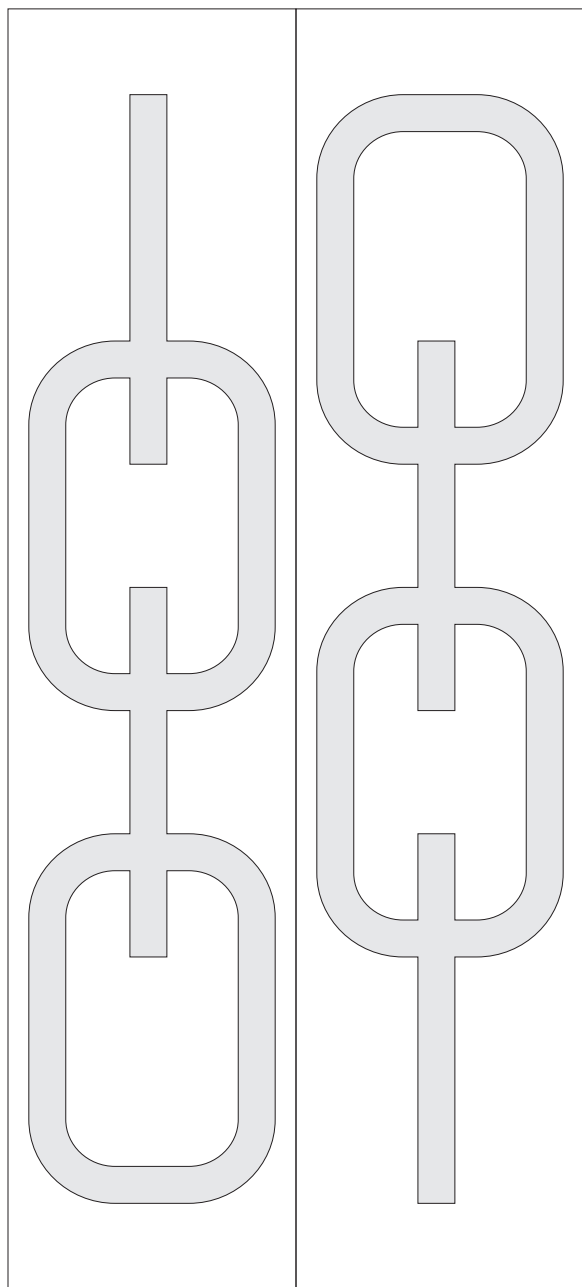
Chain Saw Handle

Cut here to install the chain then glue and sand.



No thicker than $\frac{1}{2}$ " thick or the chain won't fit.
