

When printing this pattern it is important to print it full size. When you bring up the print dialog box look in the "Page Sizing & Handling" section. Make sure the "Actual Size" is selected before you hit print.


You also only need to print the page/s you need. After the print dialog opens look for the "Pages to Print" section. You can print the current page or a range of pages. This will help save ink by not printing the title/instruction pages.





Dragonfly Art



The wire legs are optional. If you want to hang the dragonfly on the wall just eliminate the legs.








The wings are cut from 1/8" thick Baltic birch plywood. Both set should be stack cut for speed.





Use a drill to drill out the holes for the wings.
Use a sharp knife to square up the holes so the tabs on the wings will fit securely.

I used CA glue and spray activator to hole the wings in place.



If you want to add legs then use stiff wire. Drill three holes along each side of the body for the wire. I used CA glue and spray activator to hold the legs in the body. Bend the legs to make the dragonfly stand off the ground.
