Cut a front and a backer from 1/8" Thick Baltic Birch Plywood or Hardwood.




Visit <u>Seyco.com</u> for quality scroll saw supplies.





Mask off the areas around the text on the backer board and spray paint with your choice of color. Don't get paint on the edges or back.





Remove the mask and clue the front to the backer. Clamp until dry. Finish the tag with a spray lacquer/acrylic.
