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## General Pattern Information



When printing this pattern it is important to print it full size. When you bring up the print dialog box look in the “Page Sizing & Handling” section. Make sure the “Actual Size” is selected before you hit print.

You also only need to print the page/s you need. After the print dialog opens look for the “Pages to Print” section. You can print the current page or a range of pages. This will help save ink by not printing the title/instruction pages.

A small white scroll saw and a larger black scroll saw are shown. The scroll saw is a compact, vertical machine with a white base and a black handle. The scrollers drill is a larger, more complex machine with a black frame and a white base, featuring a scroll saw blade and a drill bit.

You can carve the fork back to give it a little more definition.





Freehand draw the outline of the zero.  
Carve the fork back as far as you like.  
I just carved a very small relief to give it a shadowline.



3/4" Thick
