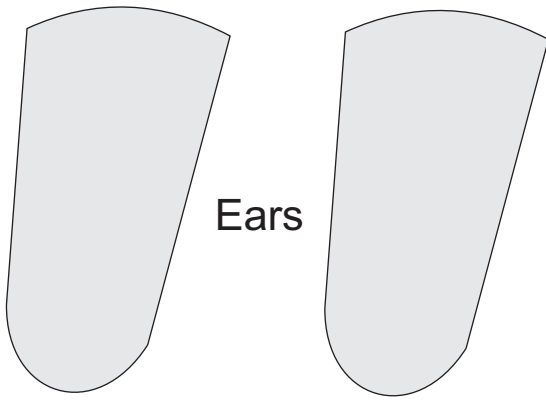

$\frac{1}{2}$ " Thick

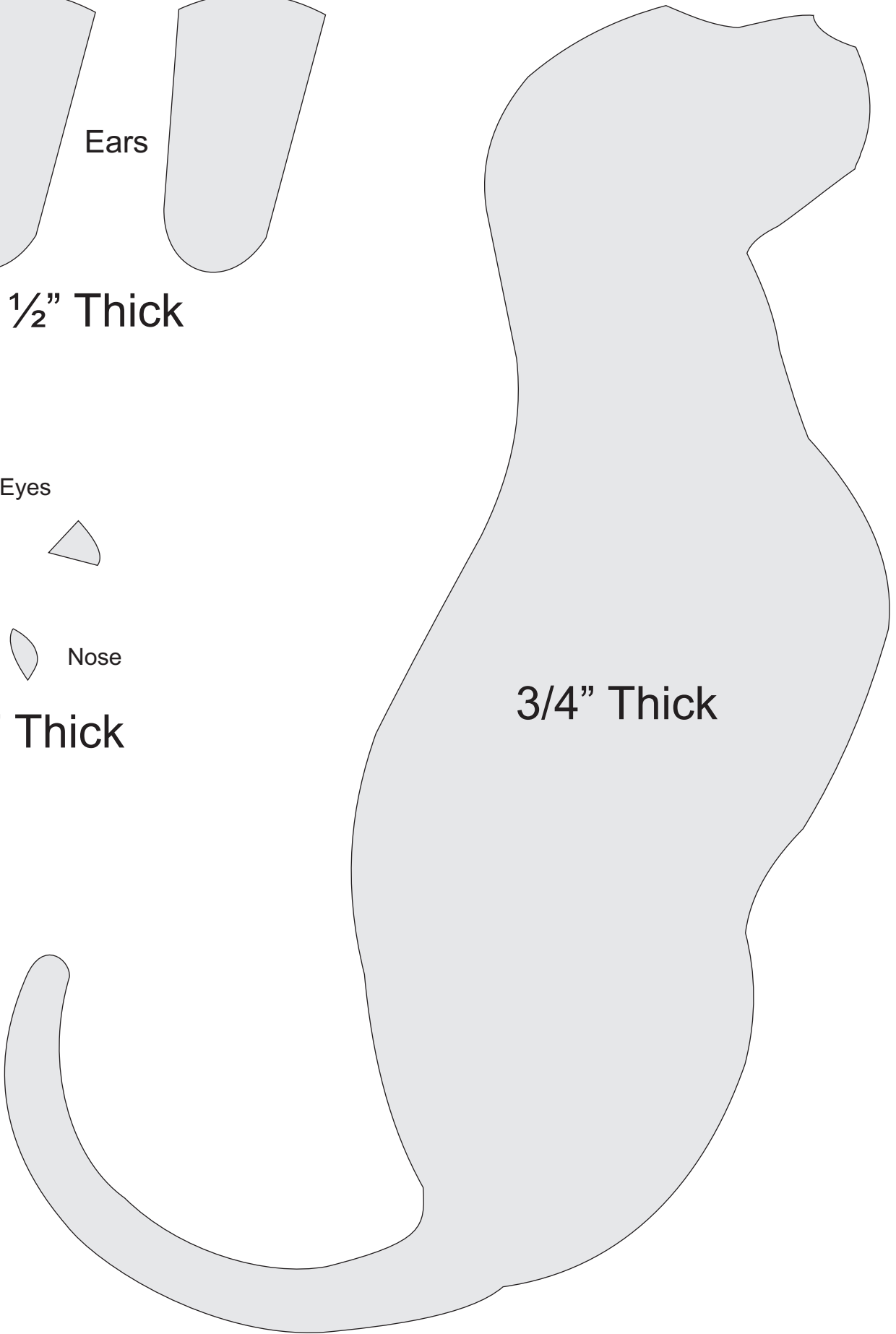


Eyes



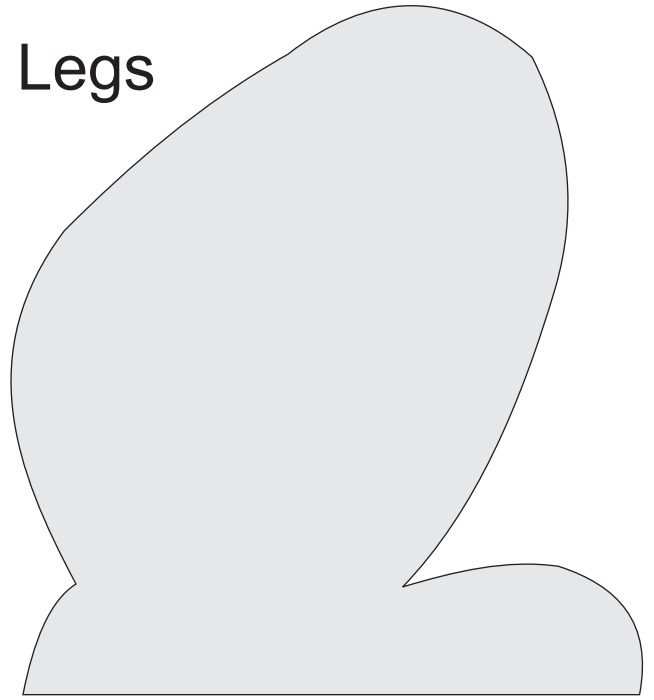
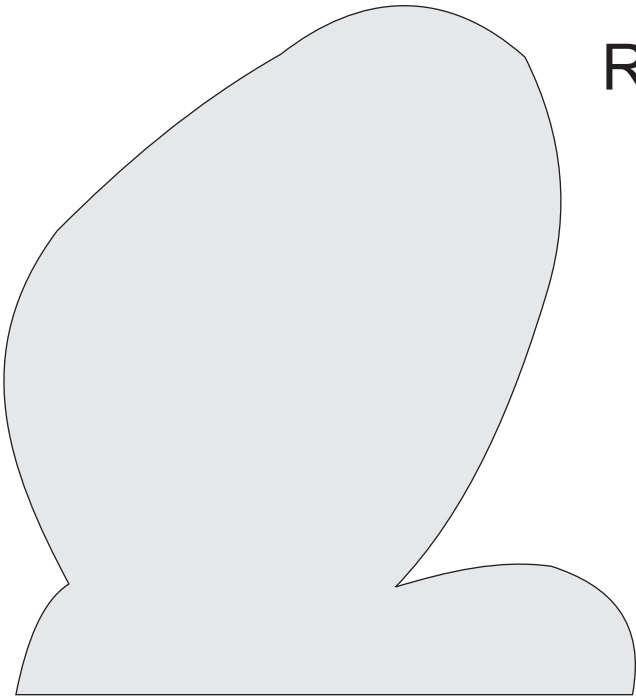
Nose

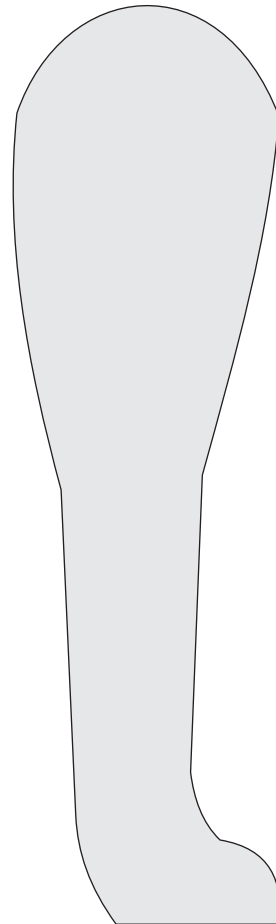
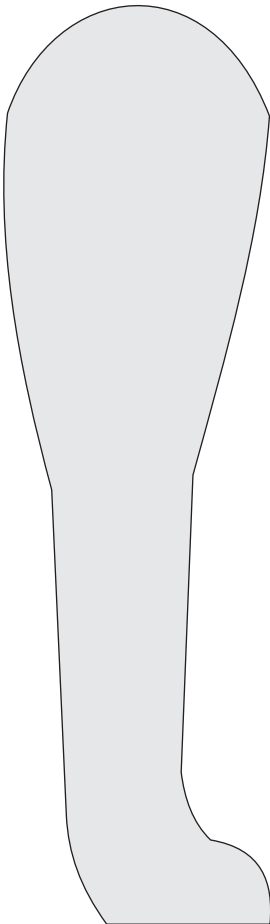


$\frac{3}{4}$ " Thick

Rear Legs

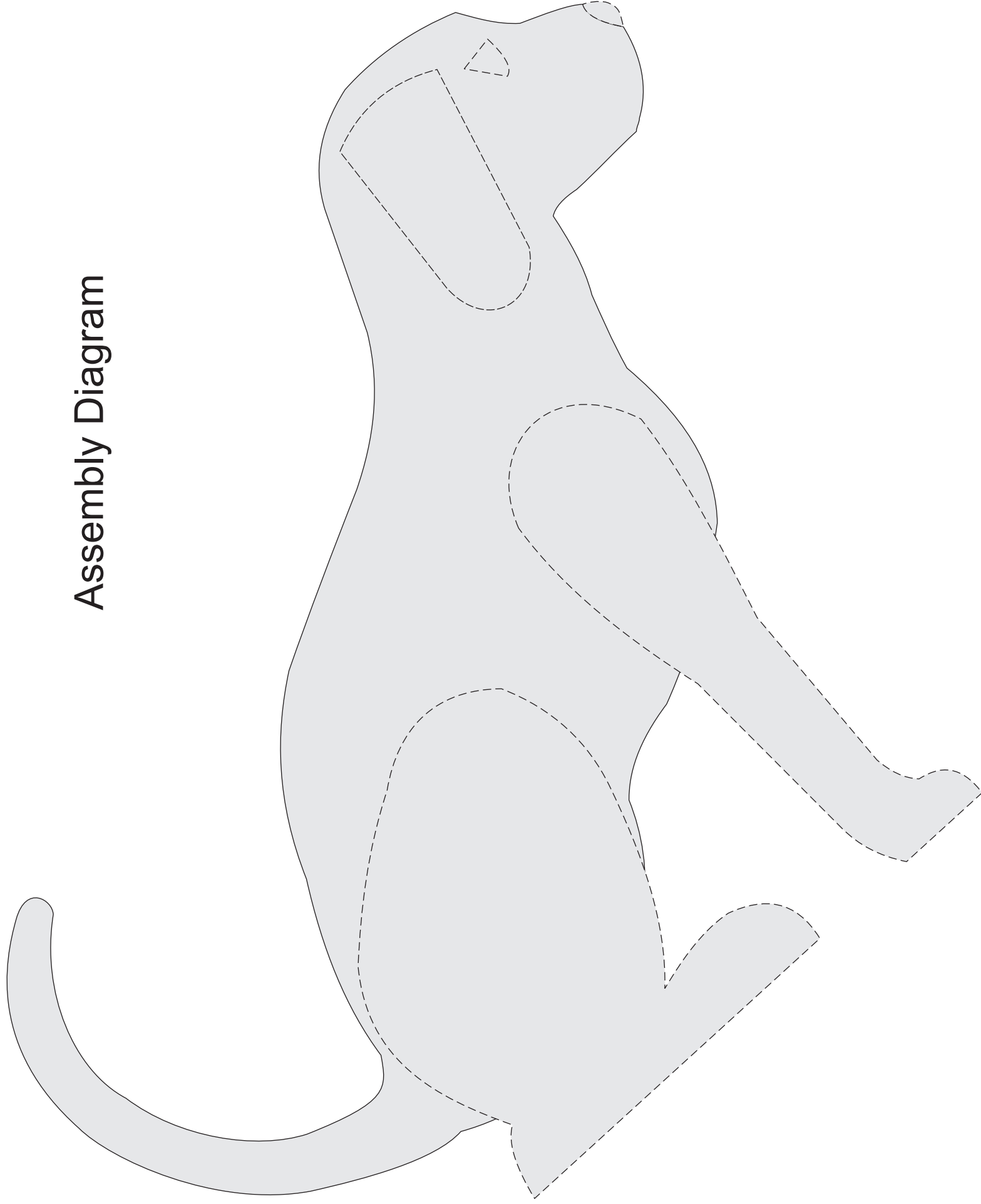

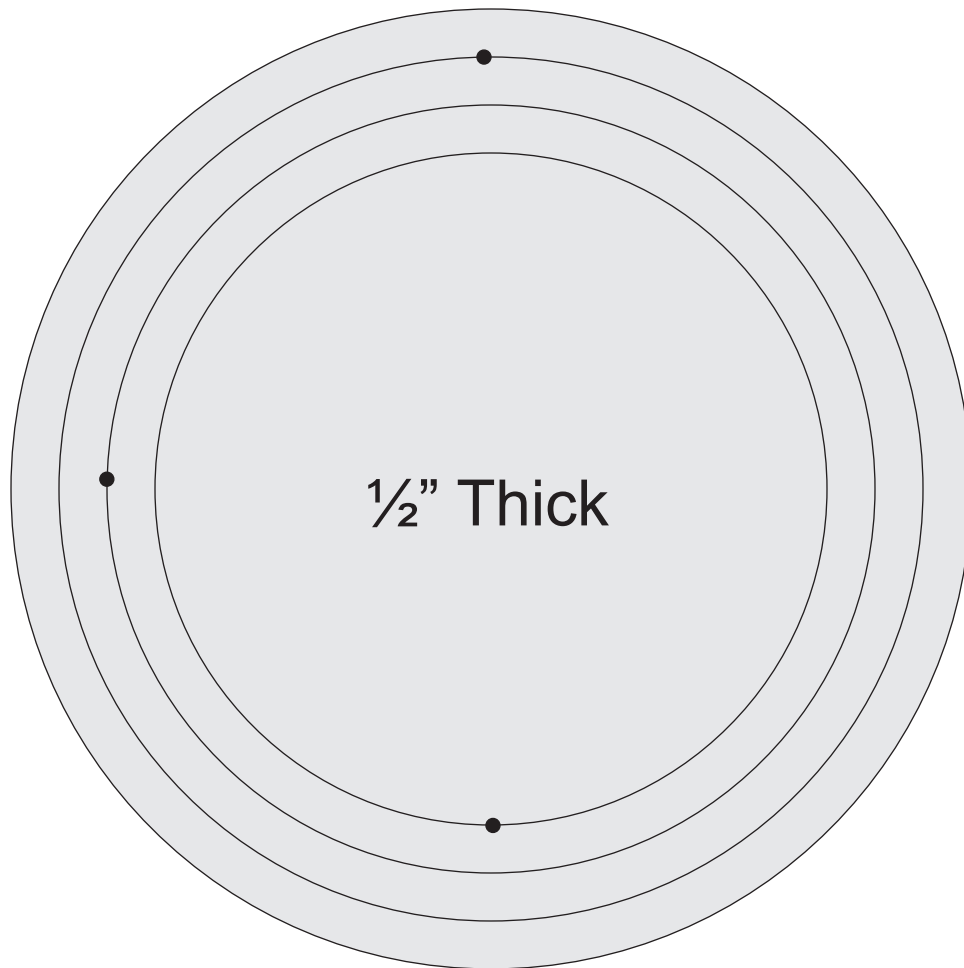
Front Legs

Collapsing Basket

Tilt saw table to 3 degrees.



Make test cuts on scrap first to make sure the bowl open the right amount. If it opens too much increase the angle of the table. If it does not open enough decrease the angle.

Cut the base 4 ½" x 11"
