




The base has two parts. This is the front. The back of the base is on the next page.

3/4" to 1" Thick



The cutting from the previous page glues to the front of this piece. I recommend you stack cut the outer perimeter of both pieces. Then remove this piece and drill in interior holes for the front of the building and make those cuts. This ensures these pieces will be identical.
