

The acrylic in 1/8" Thick. Leave the protective paper on both side of the acrylic while cutting. Apply the pattern directly to the protective. I used a #1 scroll reverse blade. The saw was set to a medium speed.








Requires an LED puck light.
The puck must be less than
3 inches in diameter and less
than 1 inch tall. I bought mine
in a 3 pack.

If your puck is a different size then you will need to modify the pattern.
















When you glue the top to the bottom the light slots must line up.

Notice that the light slit is shorter on the bottom. This gives a shelf for the acrylic to sit on.
