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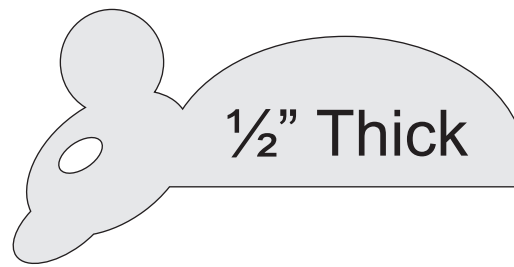
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Mouse on Cheese

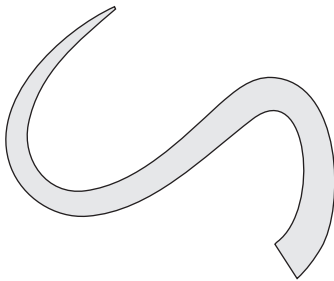


Notice how I notched between the ears. I did this by free-handing the cut on the scroll saw. After I cut the body out I put the nose on the table for support and cut the notch. You could also cut it with a carving knife or small grinding wheel. I also tapered the tail down to the tip by sanding it.

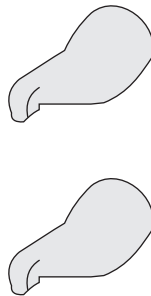




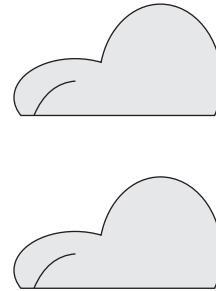
Tail



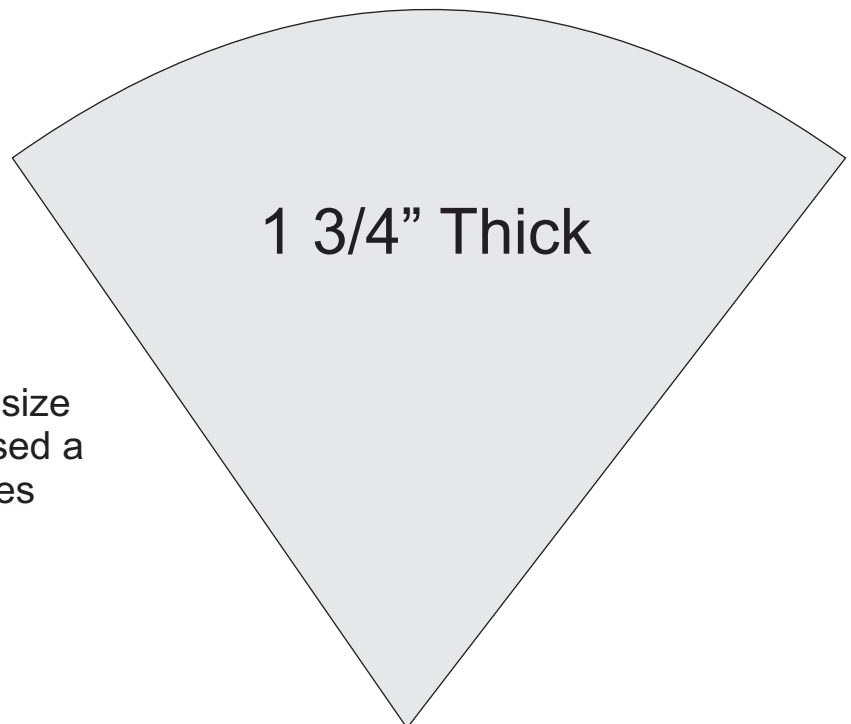
Front Legs

1/4\" Thick

After the cheese is cut use different size drill bits to add the cheese holes. I used a 1/2\" bit and a 1/4\" bit. I drilled 3 holes on each straight side.
