I downloaded the image of the Nativity from a Public Domain image site. I added the wood floor to the image to prepare it for cutting.

I image was printed on normal quality color printer paper.



I used 3M spray adhesive to glue the image to the 3/4" MDF. Make sure you use the instructions for a permanent adhesion.

I then applied several coats of spray clear enamel. I did this to give the paper a little more strength before I cut it on the scroll saw. Let everything cure before to take it to the scroll saw.





When you cut out the image make sure you stay inside the image outline. You don't want any white paper showing.

I used a #3 scroll reverse blade to try and prevent the paper from lifting. It did pretty well but the top lifted just a bit. I just glued it back down after the cutting was finished.

I applied several more coats of clear spray enamel all around the cut out.

The spray enamel make the color pop which is an added advantage.
