

These combs are made by stacking two different woods and cutting them as one. Then you separate and use the two parts to make the two toned comb. When you stack the wood you want the grain running along the length of the handle and along the width of the teeth. This gives the teeth much more strength. Use you finest blade to prevent as much loss of wood in the kerf as possible.

1/4" Thick



Arrows indicate direction of grain.
