
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Relief Cut Cross



To make the relief cut set the table to around 2 - 3 degrees. Make test cuts on scrap wood until you get a relief of about 1/4" in depth. Start at point 1 and make the first relief cut. Don't remove the pieces when you finish a cut. They will help keep the project strong as you make the next cut. Continue with cuts 2 and 3 at the same angle. For cut 4 set the table back to 90 degree for the final cut. After you finish all cuts and remove the pattern spread the bottom and apply glue. cut the base on the next page and assemble. Sand and finish.



Depending on your relief cuts you may need to adjust the size of the base.
