When printing this pattern it is important to print it full size. When you bring up the print dialog box look in the "Page Sizing & Handling" section. Make sure the "Actual Size" is selected before you hit print.

You also only need to print the page/s you need. After the print dialog opens look for the "Pages to Print" section. You can print the current page or a range of pages. This will help save ink by not printing the title/instruction pages.

### Scorpion Box with picture for bottom












I decided to make this box completely out of Baltci birch plywood. I had some extra 1/4" thick BB ply so I glued up 6 sheets to get 1.5" thickness I wanted for the walls of the box.

If you have thicker sheets then glue up what you have.




I painted the lid keeper red so the scorpion would stand out. Note that I kept a small glue surface unpainted.







Many woodworker consider the end grain of plywood to be something they need to hide. I wanted to highlight the end grain in this project.



# Lid Keeper 1/8" Thick or 1/4" Thick Paint inside the dashed ring







Print on high quality photo paper.
Glue into the bottom of the box after finishing. You can then spray the picture with a fixative for durability.
