







Mini Vase






Apply the patterns to the wood blanks.

Drill the interior holes.





Cut all the parts on the scroll saw.





Glue the back of the vase to the center section.







Glue on the front and clamp until the glue dries.






Sand the sides nice and flush.





Route or sand the edges of the vase to round them over.





Finish hand sanding to an smooth finish.

Apply the finish of your choice. I use spray acrylic.
