the bridge glued in place.

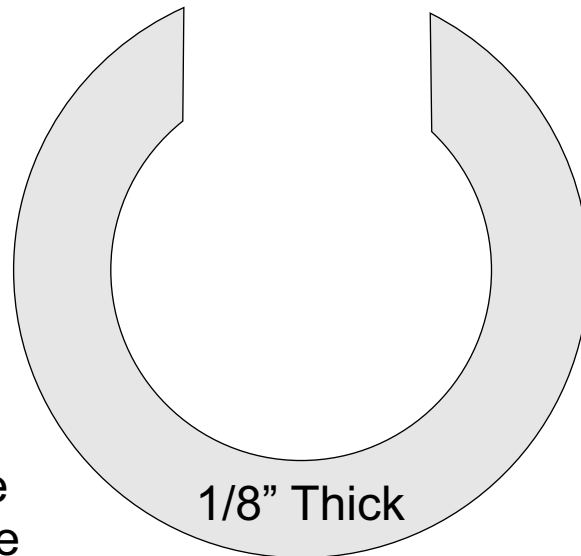
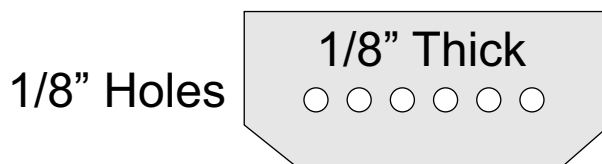
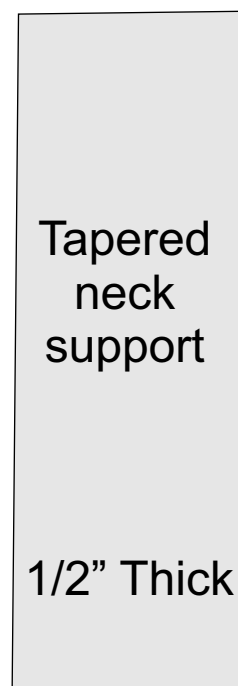
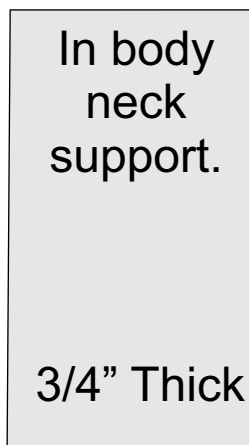
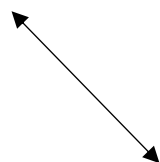


Body

Use 1/8" wooden dowel in the string holes. The pegs hold the strings in place. Use thread or fine wire for the strings. Tie a knot in each end of the string. Place the ends in the holes and glue the peg in place.
